## SUBJECT: Deauthorization of University of North Florida Specialty License Plate

## Overview:

The University of North Florida specialty license plate will be discontinued. Florida law requires the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) to discontinue the specialty license plate with the lowest number of valid registrations. As of January 1, 2024, the license plate had 1,558 valid registrations.

## Details:

On February 1, 2024, the specialty license plate for the University of North Florida will be discontinued. Please remove all inventory from your offices and PRIDE will pick it up on future deliveries. The inventory codes being discontinued are UNR, UNP, and UNA.

A vehicle owner or lessee issued a specialty license plate that has been discontinued may keep their discontinued specialty license plate for the remainder of the 10-year license plate replacement cycle. They will no longer be charged the $\$ 25$ annual specialty license plate fee that FLHSMV distributes to the University of North Florida. All other applicable registration fees will continue to be collected during the annual renewal period. No original, replacement or personalized license plate reservation transactions can be performed. If the customer chooses to switch to a different license plate before the end of their 10-year license plate cycle, all applicable fees will be charged.

Additionally, the gift certificate voucher for the University of North Florida specialty license plate is deauthorized and is no longer available to customers.
