SUBJECT: Legislative Change – Senate Bill 736 (2024) Temporary Tags

Overview:

Senate Bill 736 (2024) amended section 320.131, Florida Statutes, authorizing the Florida Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) to issue temporary tags for 60-days for eligible scenarios.

Details:

Effective April 10, 2025, the department is authorized to issue 60-day temporary tags for the following scenarios:

- 1. When the existing owner of a vehicle has submitted an application to transfer a valid out-of-state title that is subject to a lien.
- 2. When an active-duty military service member who has a valid Florida driver license provides evidence satisfactory to the department that he or she is deployed outside of the state.

The temporary tag reason codes used for the above scenarios are:

- B Transfer OOS Title with Lien (60)
- C Active-Duty Military Service Deployed OOS (60)

Procedure <u>RS-31</u> has been updated with the processing requirements for the eligible scenarios above.
