As a reminder, please follow the procedures below when requesting court testimony and record certifications:

- 1) Sections 320.05(4) and 322.201, Florida Statutes, provides that copies of properly certified driving and motor vehicle records of the Department shall be received as evidence in the courts without further authentication, and authorizes the Department to collect witness and travel fees for requested testimony by staff members.
- 2) Additionally, Sections 320.05(4) and 322.201, Florida Statutes, do not require the "machine imprint" to be used as evidence in court proceedings. Effective October 1, 2009, the Department discontinued a "machine imprint" to certify driver license and motor vehicle record documents, such as driver transcripts, prints of photos, driver license applications, signatures, motor vehicle title transactions, printouts, and address files. We will stamp these documents as "certified" with the signature of Bradley Perry.
