

FINDINGS
2007 UNIFORM TRAFFIC CITATION REPORT

Summary of Total Violations and Dispositions

- A. The total number of citations written in the state rose from 5,097,673 in 2006 to 5,273,251 in 2007, an increase of 3.44%.
- B. The total number of dispositions in the state fell from 4,090,653 in 2006 to 4,077,199 in 2007, a decline of 0.33%.
- C. The total number of pending dispositions in the state rose from 1,007,020 in 2006 to 1,196,052 in 2007, an increase of 18.77%.

Summary of State Total DUI Violations and DUI Convictions

- D. Violations for DUI in the state rose from 63,591 in 2006 to 64,410 in 2007, an increase of 1.29%.
- E. DUI convictions in the state rose from 34,638 in 2006 to 35,372 in 2007, an increase of 2.12%.
- F. The total number of pending DUI dispositions fell from 21,217 in 2006 to 20,919 in 2007, a decrease of 1.40%.

Summary of State Total Seat Belt and Child Restraint Citations*

- G. For unbelted drivers, citations in the state fell from 300,623 in 2006 to 267,297 in 2007, a decrease of 11.09%.
- H. For unbelted passengers under the age of 18, citations in the state fell from 21,372 in 2006 to 19,989 in 2007, a decrease of 6.47%.
- I. For unbelted passengers over the age of 18, citations in the state fell from 29,928 in 2006 to 25,352 in 2007, a decrease of 15.29%.
- J. Child restraint citations in the state fell from 21,273 in 2006 to 20,823 in 2007, a decrease of 2.12%.
- K. Seatbelt and Child restraint citations (total) in the state dropped from 373,196 in 2006 to 333,461, a decrease of 10.65%

*Unlike prior year's UTC Annual reports, this year's Seatbelt and Child restraint citation data above was drawn from the detail report including all citations written.

Electronic Citations*

- L. 160 of 423 (37.8%) Florida Law Enforcement Agencies are using Electronic Citation writing systems in their vehicles
- M. The number of citations written electronically increased from 885,620 in 2006 to 1,285,232 in 2007; a gain of 45.12%
