Excerpted from Florida Statute 316.305: "Florida Ban on Texting While Driving Law." Law enforcement officers can stop motor vehicles and issue citations as a secondary offense to persons who are texting while driving. A person may not operate a motor vehicle while manually typing or entering multiple letters, numbers, symbols, or other characters into a wireless communications device or while sending or reading data on such a device for the purpose of nonvoice interpersonal communication, including, but not limited to, communication methods known as texting, e-mailing, and instant messaging. For the purposes of this paragraph, a motor vehicle that is stationary is not being operated and is not subject to the prohibition in this paragraph. ***This law went into effect October 1, 2013.**
