IN THE EVENT THE DEPARTMENT VEHICLE CRASH IS MORE SERIOUS IN NATURE, THE DISTRICT COMMANDER SHALL BE NOTIFIED. IF THE CRASH OCCURS ON A HOLIDAY OR WEEKEND, THE ON-CALL CAPTAIN SHALL BE NOTIFIED. THIS WILL SATISFY THE DISTRICT COMMANDER NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENT.

THE ON-DUTY TWS SHALL BE THE INITIAL NOTIFICATION CONTACT FOR ALL OF THE EVENTS LISTED ON THIS CHART. THE RESPONSIBILITY OF MAKING THE APPROPRIATE NOTIFICATIONS THROUGH THE CHAIN OF COMMAND IS VESTED IN THE TWS, UNTIL AN OFFICER OF HIGHER RANK DESIGNATES OTHERWISE.
