<p>These license plates may only be issued for the following types of vehicles:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Automobiles for private use and for-hire. 2. Trucks weighing 7,999 pounds or less. 3. Motor homes or truck campers which are NOT "for hire" or "commercial" use. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ The applicant must be a Florida resident and must hold a valid amateur radio station license recognized by the Federal Communications Commission. ◆ HSMV 83041, Application for Amateur Radio License Plate, must be legibly completed in full. ◆ Proof of Florida insurance indicating personal injury protection and property damage liability coverage is required. (Applicant may submit a copy of their insurance card, policy or binder, or may complete the insurance affidavit form HSMV 83330.) ◆ Submit a copy of your current vehicle registration certificate. ◆ Submit a copy of your Amateur Radio Station License. ◆ Contact your local county tax collector's office or license plate agency for fee information.
