<b>APPLICATION REQUIREMENTS</b>				
<p>These license plates may only be issued for the following types of vehicles:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Automobiles for private use and for-hire.</li> <li>2. Trucks weighing 7,999 pounds or less.</li> <li>3. Motor homes or truck campers which are NOT "for hire" or "commercial" use.</li> </ol> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>◆ The applicant must be a Florida resident and must hold a valid amateur radio station license recognized by the Federal Communications Commission.</li> <li>◆ HSMV 83041, Application for Amateur Radio License Plate, must be legibly completed in full.</li> <li>◆ Proof of Florida insurance indicating personal injury protection and property damage liability coverage is required. (Applicant may submit a copy of their insurance card, policy or binder, or may complete the insurance affidavit form HSMV 83330.)</li> <li>◆ Submit a copy of your current vehicle registration certificate.</li> <li>◆ Submit a copy of your Amateur Radio Station License.</li> <li>◆ Contact your local county tax collector's office or license plate agency for fee information.</li> </ul>
