# Procedure TL-12

## **Motor Vehicle Procedure Manual**

#### **Title and Lien**

## **Duplicate and Lost In Transit With Transfer**

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#### **Legal Authority**

<u>Sections 319.17(1) and (2)</u> and <u>Section 328.15(5)</u>, Florida Statutes, authorizes FLHSMV to adopt such rules as it deems necessary or proper, and to prescribe all forms required by or deemed necessary for the administration of the Chapter.

#### **Description and Use**

This procedure provides information and instructions to assist employees of the Tax Collector, License Plate Agent and The Florida Department of Highway Safety And Motor Vehicles (FLHSMV) in processing requests for duplicate titles with a simultaneous transfer, duplicate titles with a salvage brand, and lost in transit titles with simultaneous transfer.

**Required Documentation and Special Instructions** 

To process an application for title using this procedure, both the seller and purchaser must be present and

provide acceptable identification as listed in <u>TL-01 Signatures Requirements</u>. If both seller and purchaser

cannot be present, the seller must obtain a duplicate title certificate prior to transferring ownership to the

purchaser. Refer to Procedure TL-11 Transfer of Florida Certificate of Title for transfer of title instructions. A

power of attorney cannot be used when following this procedure. Seller includes a dealer if the dealer is the

registered owner.

An exception to this process is when an insurance company is involved, and a total loss is being paid. The

seller would not have to be present, and the appropriate power of attorney could be used. Refer to Section

C.

When the title record reflects an electronic title status, a Duplicate or Lost in Transit with Transfer can NOT

be processed.

A. When the application is based on a Florida certificate of title record and the seller wishes to transfer

ownership and cannot locate the certificate of title, the following documentation must accompany the

application:

1. Form HSMV 82101 Application for Duplicate or Lost In Transit/Reassignment for a Motor Vehicle,

Mobile Home or Vessel Title Certificate, completed in the applicable sections, by the seller(s) and the

purchaser(s) as the applicant for certificate of title.

2. Lien satisfaction(s) for any liens shown on the motor vehicle, vessel or mobile home records.

3. Form HSMV 82994 Motor Vehicle Dealer Title Reassignment Supplement,

must be completed by the dealer, showing sales tax was collected and the

odometer reading was verified, if applicable, unless the vehicle is exempt.

4. Florida sales tax or specify sales tax information on form HSMV 82101, under the "Buyer's Application"

Attestment and Signatures" area.

5. The Florida license plate number transferred to or purchased for the motor vehicle, or a non-use

affidavit. Provide the mobile home decal number purchased for or the RP decal transferred to or

purchased for the mobile home. If the transaction is for a mobile home, the seller must pay any

applicable back tax due. The purchaser(s) must also pay any current sales tax due. A non-use

affidavit is not acceptable for mobile homes. Submit the Florida registration number transferred to

or issued for the vessel, or a non-use affidavit. If a non-use affidavit is provided for a vessel a non-use

registration must be issued to transfer the vessel registration record into the new owner's name.

6. Duplicate and Transfer of Title fees will be collected. The motor vehicle issuance system will charge

a service fee for both transactions.

B. When the application is based on a Florida Certificate of Title record and the seller has not received the

certificate of title (it must be more than 20 days and less than 180 days since the duplicate certificate of

title was issued), but the seller wishes to transfer ownership:

1. This transaction should be processed as a duplicate fast title at no fee (lost in transit) and have the

seller sign it over to the purchaser.

2. Form HSMV 82101 completed in the applicable sections by the seller(s), and the purchaser(s) as the

applicant for the certificate of title.

3. Lien satisfaction(s) for any liens, shown on the motor vehicle, vessel or mobile home records.

4. Florida sales tax or specify sales tax information on form <u>HSMV 82101</u>, under the "Buyer's Application"

Attestment and Signatures" area.

5. The Florida license plate number transferred to or purchased for the motor vehicle, or a non-use

affidavit. Provide the mobile home decal number purchased for or the RP decal transferred to or

purchased for the mobile home. If the transaction is for a mobile home, the seller must pay any

applicable back tax due. The purchaser(s) must pay current sales tax due. A non-use affidavit is not

acceptable for mobile homes. Submit the Florida registration number transferred to or issued for

the vessel or a non-use affidavit. If a non-use affidavit is provided for a vessel, a non-use registration

must be issued to transfer the vessel registration record into the new owner's name.

6. Transfer of title fees will be collected.

C. When an insurance company makes a total loss payoff and the owner cannot locate the actual certificate

of title to transfer to the insurance company for a Salvage Certificate of Title, the following

documentation must accompany the application (see Procedure TL-36 Total Loss Settlements Involving

<u>Insurance Companies</u>):

For vessels, refer to Section A (1-5) in this procedure, as salvage is not applicable.

1. Form <u>HSMV 82101</u>, completed in the applicable sections, by the seller(s).

2. Form <u>HSMV 82101</u>, completed in the applicable sections, by an authorized agent for the insurance

company, as applicant for the certificate of title.

3. Form HSMV 82363 Application for Salvage Title/Certificate of Destruction, completed by an

authorized agent of the insurance company.

4. Lien satisfaction(s) for any liens shown on the motor vehicle or mobile home records.

5. A non-use affidavit is required for motor vehicles. A non-use affidavit is acceptable for a mobile home

when the application is being made by an insurance company and they state that the certificate of

title is for insurance purposes.

6. Duplicate and Transfer of Title fees will be collected. The motor vehicle issuance system will charge

a service fee for both transactions.

If the certificate of title was lost in transit and it has been more than 20 days and less than 180 days since

the duplicate certificate of title was issued, process a duplicate fast title at no fee (lost in transit) and

have the seller sign it over to the purchaser/insurance company.
