### Facebook:

- Share the road with motorcyclists, bicyclists and commercial motor vehicles to ensure that everyone arrives to and from their destination alive. #ShareTheRoadFL #ArriveAliveFL
- Motorcyclists and bicyclists are vulnerable road users! Make sure you drive safely and cautiously to ensure they arrive alive. #ArriveAliveFL #ShareTheRoadFL
- Motorcyclists are entitled to an entire lane. Never attempt to share a lane with a motorcycle! #ShareTheRoadFL
- It is difficult to gauge the speed of a motorcycle; they may appear to be much farther away than they really are. Look twice and #ShareTheRoadFL! #ArriveAliveFL
- When making a turn, remember to yield to any bicyclist in the bike lane. Make your turn behind the bicyclists once they have passed you. #ShareTheRoadFL #ArriveAliveFL
- Stay out of a commercial vehicles “No Zone” or blind spots! If you drive in a “No Zone,” the commercial vehicle driver will not be able to see you. #ShareTheRoadFL #ArriveAliveFL

### Twitter:

- All road users must stay alert, watch for bicyclists and motorcyclists and share the road! #ShareTheRoadFL
- Did you know: A bicycle is legally defined as a vehicle? #ShareTheRoadFL
- Give bicyclists 3 ft of clearance when driving alongside or passing them – it’s the law! #ShareTheRoad
- Give motorcycles space! Always keep a 4-second buffer zone between your car and a motorcyclist. #ShareTheRoadFL
- Share the road with commercial vehicles. Stay out of their “No Zones” and don’t tailgate. #ShareTheRoadFL
- Always watch for motorcycles and bicycles. Look twice before pulling into an intersection or changing lanes. #ShareTheRoadFL
